## COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Prospective consultants must take a written examination. Each course includes:

- Ten hours of lectures, including a supplemental subject lecture
- A multiple-choice exam (open book/notes) based on the lectures. Exams are optional, but must be taken by those who apply for NGC certification.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR CREDIT

National Garden Clubs (NGC) Certification is only available to members of an NGC garden club. Exams are optional but must be taken by students wishing to be certified as an NGC Landscape Design Consultant.

Each of the four courses consist of ten hours of lectures. Attendance is mandatory for the student to be able to take the exam and receive credit.

Refreshers do not need to take the exams.

For certification students must complete all four courses and exams with a passing grade of 70 or above.

Refreshers can only take one course per year for refresher credit.

All lectures and exams are open to the public regardless of NGC membership. If you are taking the course but are not a member of an NGC garden club, then register as 'Audit only'.

## FAQs

- There are five lectures per day with breaks.
- Instructor outlines will be emailed to all registered students and refreshers prior to the course beginning.
- Students may take more than one course in a given year.
- The Courses and NGC Certification do not confer professional status.
- Students can take the courses in any order.
- Arizona does not follow daylight savings time.
